Bulldogs are expected to be judged on a ramp. No dogs or puppies are to be sold at the show site.

Unless otherwise allowed by AKC Rules, entries may be withdrawn, changed or altered <u>prior to the closing date and time</u>. **Email** is preferred for these changes. Email notification of withdraw, move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary.**NO TEXT, VERBAL OR PHONE** messages are accepted to withdraw or change an entry at any time. The exhibitor is advised to keep the receipt of email received from the secretary until the show date.

Each show is considered a separate event and requires full entry fees.

When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest price class is considered the first entry.

Refunds for incorrect calculation of fees is at the discretion of the club.

No entry may be sent by any method that requires a signature for delivery.

Entries must be received by the deadline. Post mark date on envelopes do not create a valid entry, delivery by deadline only.

Make checks payable to BCOD, US Funds only. Telephone and FAX entries will not be accepted. Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with an international money order in U.S. funds.

No dogs in the restrooms. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave the show/trial grounds. Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Shows. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the show.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including those in the Premium List, but not limited by them.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have proper vaccinations.

All prizes and trophies must be claimed the day of the show and will be presented in the ring. None will be mailed. Trophies not claimed on the day of show are forfeited.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging.

Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from the Show Secretary or may be obtained from the AKC.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an Event Service Fee of \$3 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2).

Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, please contact the Show Secretary.

The hosting club may decline an entry for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove a dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

The hosting clubs may cancel any events due to extreme weather conditions.

The club is not responsible for loss or injury to anyone attending this show.

The club will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, regardless of the cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

All dogs must be on a leash or confined to crates except when being judged.

Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.

A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.

Crates and grooming tables are not allowed within 10 feet of the rings.

Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

Fees must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. accounts, in U.S. funds.

Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.
