Veteran Dog/Veteran Bitch For dogs and bitches 6 years of age and older. Open to Champions and Non-Champions alike. Dogs/Bitches judged separately.

Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Dog/Bitch class at Independent Specialties.

IMPORTANT— TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (CH 11, Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging at this show.

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and Junior Showmanship and is open to breeders and owners of Bulldogs that on the day of the show are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Professional Handlers may show their OWN DOGS ONLY. A Champion of Record may not be entered or shown.

Each dog, bitch MUST be entered in a Regular Class at the same show. Entry fee is \$20 for each dog, bitch and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes".

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Bulldogs are expected to be judged on a ramp. No dogs or puppies are to be sold at the show site.

- 1. Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club (AKC) Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or owner's Agent entering a dog or a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete. Conditional entries are not accepted.
- 2. Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from the Show Secretary or may be obtained from the AKC.
- 3. A recording fee of 50 cents and a Event Service Fee of \$3 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2).
- 4. Judging programs will be emailed to the address given on the entry form.
- 5. The hosting club may decline an entry for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove a dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.
- The hosting clubs may cancel any events due to extreme weather conditions.
- 7. The club is not responsible for loss or injury to anyone attending this show.
- 8. The club will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, regardless of the cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- 9. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the show.
- 10. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- 11. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- 12. All dogs must be on a leash or confined to crates except when being judged.
- Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
- 14. A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.
- 15. Crates and grooming tables are not allowed within 10 feet of the rings.
- 16. Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of a discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Secretary should be advised at once. Trophies not claimed on the day of show are forfeited.
- 17. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
- 18. Fees must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. accounts, in U.S. funds.
- 19.Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 20.If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 21. All rights to advertise, publicize, televise, photograph or otherwise promote this event are vested in each individual club on its show date. All persons and animals on the Show Site at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending and/or participating therein, grant to each club the right to photograph, televise, audiotape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
- 22.Exhibitors must not wear anything in the ring identifying them with any club or organization.



Heading South on I-25, take exit 217B to merge onto I-270E toward Aurora/Limon. Merge onto I-70E. Keep left to stay on I-70E. Follow signs for Denver Int'l Airport/Pena Blvd/Chambers Rd. Take exit 289 toward Ft. Collins/Colorado Springs. Take Gun Club Rd to Fairgrounds Access Road (use the middle lane to follow signs for Colorado Springs. Use the 2nd from the left lane to turn left at the 1st cross street onto E Colfax Ave/I-70 Frontage Road. Turn right onto Gun Club Road. Turn left onto CO-30 E/S Gun Club Road. Turn left onto Airline Rd/E Quincy Avenue. Turn right onto Fairgrounds Access Road.

Heading North on I-25, take exit 200 for I-225N toward I-70/Limon. Take exit 4 to merge onto CO-83 S/S Parker Road. Turn left onto E Quincy Avenue. Turn right onto Fairgrounds Access Road.

From I-70, take exit 289 toward Ft. Collins/Colorado Springs. Take Gun Club Rd to Fairgrounds Access Road (use the middle lane to follow signs for Colorado Springs). Use the 2nd from the left lane to turn left at the 1st cross street onto E Colfax Ave/1-70 Frontage Road. Turn right onto Gun Club Road. Turn 9ft onto CO-30 E/S Gun Club Road. Turn left onto Airline Rd/E Quincy Avenue. Turn right onto Fairgrounds Access Road.

AKC National Owner Handled Series

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition. The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be allowed to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Junior Showmanship

Novice Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won ten (10) first place awards in an open class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1- October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility timeframe for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

 variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13
 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull
 Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels
 (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam Information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
