### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**Veteran Dog/Bitch (All shows)-** Winner of this class, if otherwise undefeated, compete in Best of Breed Competition. Veteran Dog/Bitch (6yrs and older)- open to champions and non-champions. A dog may be entered in the Veteran Class without being entered in any other class. Dogs/Bitches will be judged separately. Chapter 11, Section 8 AKC Rules, neutered males may be entered as a Veteran Dog/ Spayed females may be entered as Veteran Bitch.

*Novice Dog/Bitch, Brood Bitch classes, Rescue Parade, Parade of Champions are not offered.*

**IMPORTANT–** TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (CH 11, Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging at this show.

### SWEEPSTAKES (Saturday AM Show)

Sweepstakes is open to Bulldogs that on the day of the show are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Professional Handlers may show their OWN DOGS ONLY. A Champion of Record may not be entered or shown.

Each dog/bitch MUST be entered in a Regular Class at the same show. Entry fee is \$25 and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes".

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

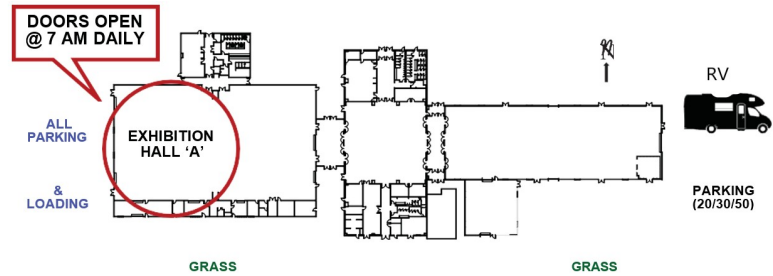

Take exit 289 toward Ft. Collins/Colorado Springs. Take Gun Club Rd to Fairgrounds Access Road (use the middle lane to follow signs for Colorado Springs). 1. Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club (AKC) Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or owner's Agent entering a dog or a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete. Conditional entries are not accepted.
2. **Make checks payable to Laura Anninos** No cash will be accepted. **ENTRIES CLOSE 6PM MT, Wednesday, APRIL 8, 2026 at the Show Secretary's address.** Laura Anninos 8115 E Harvard Circle, Denver, CO 80231, [laura.anninos@gmail.com](mailto:laura.anninos@gmail.com)
3. Entries will be accepted by sending a completed Entry Form to the Show Secretary by mail, email, or online and paying the appropriate fees using PayPal to [laura.anninos@gmail.com](mailto:laura.anninos@gmail.com). Online entry made be made at [https://www.picalo.com/event/akc\\_entry\\_picalo7081/picalo\\_entry\\_menu.php](https://www.picalo.com/event/akc_entry_picalo7081/picalo_entry_menu.php)
4. Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from the Show Secretary or may be obtained from the AKC.
5. AKC Recording/Event Service Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2). Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank.
6. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, natural disaster, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
7. There will be a \$35 fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds.
8. A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.
9. Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of a discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Secretary should be advised at once. Trophies not claimed on the day of show are forfeited.
10. Fees must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. accounts, in U.S. funds.
11. Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

## AKC National Owner Handled Series

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition. The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be allowed to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

**Professional handlers** are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

## Junior Showmanship

**Novice Class:** For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class:** For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Master Class:** For Junior Handlers, aged 9-17, who, at the time entries close, have won ten (10) first place awards in an open class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1- October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility timeframe for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

*NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.*

## AKC Temperament Test (ATT)

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) was developed to bring focus and provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions.

The ATT tests how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation and an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

1. Social
2. Auditory
3. Visual
4. Tactile
5. Proprioceptive (motion)
6. Unexpected stimulus
